SCHOOL NURSE	SCHOOL BASED HEALTH CENTER
 School Nurses are members of school district staff and are governed by state and federal education rule and statute. Serves all students; Provide case management for chronic and acute student health conditions; Coordinate mandated screening Train and delegate specific nursing tasks to other school personnel, drafts student health plans, assist with IEP and 504 plans Provide mental health crisis intervention; Works with student's primary doctor. Medicaid is first payer Works under FERPA. 	 School-Based Health Centers (SBHCs) are public health primary care clinics located in a school building or on school campus. Sees students by appointment; Staffed by nurse practitioners, nurses, qualified mental health staff who are employees of community health care agency (County Health Dept.); Perform routine physical exams, sports physicals, reproductive health services and well child care Diagnose and treat acute and chronic illness, and treat minor injuries. Provide mental health assessments and services; Bills private insurance , Medicaid 2nd payer
