1P1 Technical Skill Attainment - CTE concentrators who successfully completed a technical skill assessment following the completion of their CTE program during the reporting year or previous year. All 17 colleges administer technical skill assessments.

1P2 Academic Skill Attainment - CTE concentrators who made progress of C or better in academic courses during the program year. This measurement is not required by USDOE but is an Oregon-only indicator. For more Postsecondary Perkins information: <http://www.ode.state.or.us/search/page/?id=3871>

2P1 Credential, Certificate, or Degree - CTE concentrators receiving an award and left college by Fall, 2015.

3P1 Student Retention or Transfer - CTE concentrators who did not earn an associate degree in the program year and who continued to be enrolled in postsecondary education in the subsequent year.

4P1 Student Placement - CTE concentrators who completed a CTE program and entered employment or retained employment.

5P1 Non-traditional Participation - CTE participants from underrepresented gender groups in programs that lead to employment in non-traditional fields.

5P2 Non-traditional Completion - CTE participants from underrepresented gender groups who complete a program in non-traditional fields and left college by Fall, 2015.
